1. Review Minutes

The minutes of the Jan 20, 2014 council meeting were reviewed, amended and adopted.

- 2. Financial Review
  - a. Financial Statement
    - 1) Administration costs were a little over budget.
    - 2) Supplies will be transferred to repairs and maintenance.
    - 3) The "brown out" repairs are approximately \$2,700.
    - 4) Will Carter will ensure that all invoices are paid in time.
    - 5) The January 2014 is under budget.
  - b. Arrears

112 CP remains in arrears. Will Carter will email the owner. 2 others units in arrears by small amounts.

- 3. Maintenance Items
  - a. The Building Inspection draft report has been reviewed by council. A final report is expected before the next council meeting.
  - b. The back up generator did not function properly during the power outage on Feb 15, 2014. The back up generator is a vital piece of equipment as it runs 3 sump pumps. It is 21 years old. Roger Taylor recommended that we purchase a new generator powered by diesel, which is more efficient than gas. He also recommended that we have a spare portable one as a back up, and try to locate a local service company. Council agreed. Roger also recommended that a man hole cover remover also be purchased to enable fast and efficient access to the electrical sump pump station in an emergency. Council also agreed to this.
  - c. Recycling signs and transition b/f.
- 4. Security Items
  - a. Sections on the garage gate have been sawn off in break-in attempts. Roger Taylor requested quotes for a new gate. The cost will be around \$6000. He did not receive the requested photographs before this meeting. He will email the photograph to the strata members and the council members will vote by email.
  - b. Council discussed upgrading security access control. Roger Taylor will contact owners for feedback.
- 5. Other
  - a. Bike area clean-up b/f
  - b. Will Carter brought information about a company that manufactures water detectors. They are efficient in detecting even a minute leak from eg a dish washer, washing machine, etc. Will will forward information to council.
  - c. There has been a complaints about a bike being padlocked at the front entrance of CP. A notice will be put up that bikes are not allowed to be padlocked at the front entrance and if not removed it will be considered "dumped" and taken away.
